ArcGIS for Desktop allows you to analyze your data and author [geographic knowledge](#) to examine relationships, test predictions, and ultimately make better decisions.

Through your membership in the International Map Industry Association (www.imiamaps.org) and contribution, the software is available in two license levels—Basic or Standard (formerly ArcView and ArcEditor respectively). These license levels share the same core applications, user interface, and development environment. Each license level provides additional GIS functionality as you move from Basic to Standard.
