U.S. Forest Service Trails Data Management – A Stewardship Approach

Jaime Schmidt is the Acting Assistant Director for the U. S. Forest Service Office of Recreation, Heritage and Volunteer Resources in Washington, D.C. Prior to serving in this capacity, Jaime has long served as the U.S. Forest Service’s National Trail Program Manager. With over 159,000 miles of Forest Service trails across 154 national forests and grasslands nationwide, she leads the agency’s efforts to provide a valued system of trails that connect people to outdoor experiences and their public lands. Jaime’s career as a recreation and trail management professional has included positions at district, forest, regional, and national levels in Alaska, Idaho, Montana, and Washington DC. She has also worked in land management planning, interpretive planning, and conservation education in Brazil, Honduras, and the Galapagos Islands in Ecuador through the Forest Service International Program and the US Peace Corps.
